

Animal Families!

Read the names of each male, female and young farm animal. Ask students to identify the family name. Students may want to research additional animals to learn about.

You may want to write the various names in each group on slips of paper and pass the names out to your students. Instruct children to try to find those students with coordinating names to complete the animal group. Example: Duck, Duck, Drake and Duckling.

Write the following list of farm animals names on the class board. Ask students to write any 24 animal names on his or her bingo card. Use the same directions as you might for regular bingo with one additional rule: Tell the children that they must make the sound of the given animal when its name is called if they have it on their bingo card!
