



Color Palette

Use these color palette patterns in a variety of ways in the classroom.

1. Teach young children the primary and secondary colors by giving each student their own palette and asking them to color the paint marks the appropriate colors.

2. Use the palette to denote reading groups or classroom helpers by noting students' names on the paint marks. The paint brush can be used to point to one particular group or individual student name.

3. Give each student their own blank palette patterns and award them with colorful paper paint marks when work is completed or behavior is improved.

4. Create a matching activity by writing questions on the palette patterns and answers on the paint brushes. Children match the correct brush to the appropriate palette.
