Cornucopia

Students will love making their own "Cornucopias."

Cut out the Cornucopia from colored construction paper including the center circle. Paste it to a larger sheet of black paper. Cut the harvest fruits and vegetables from construction paper and color them with crayons. Children can paste one fruit or vegetable to the Cornucopia, as an award, when assignments are completed.

Another idea: have children list reasons they are thankful on the back of the fruits and vegetables. Students can tape them to the Cornucopia. On Thanksgiving Day, they can be removed and read to the family.

The Cornucopia can also be enlarged on butcher paper and displayed on the class bulletin board.
