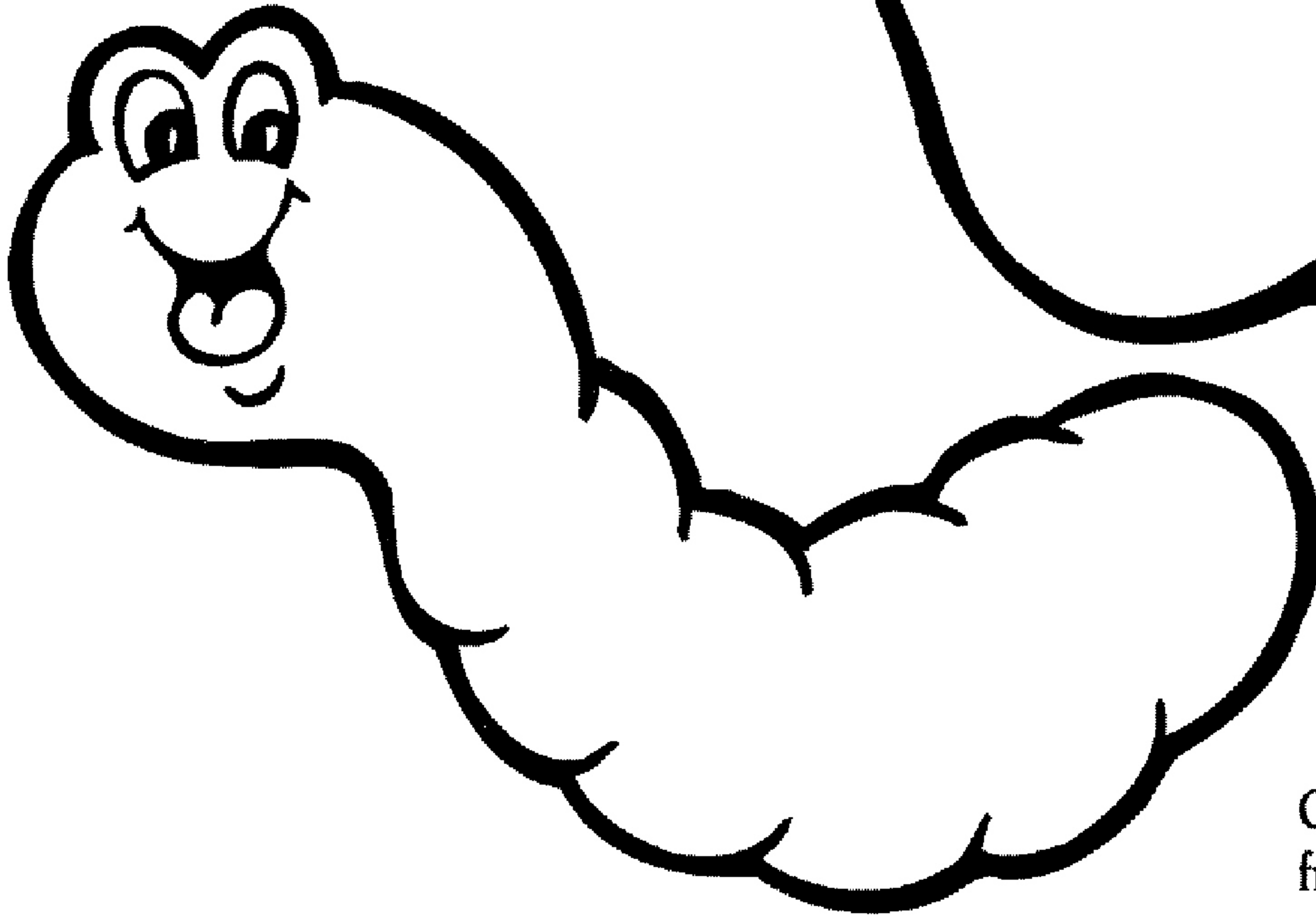
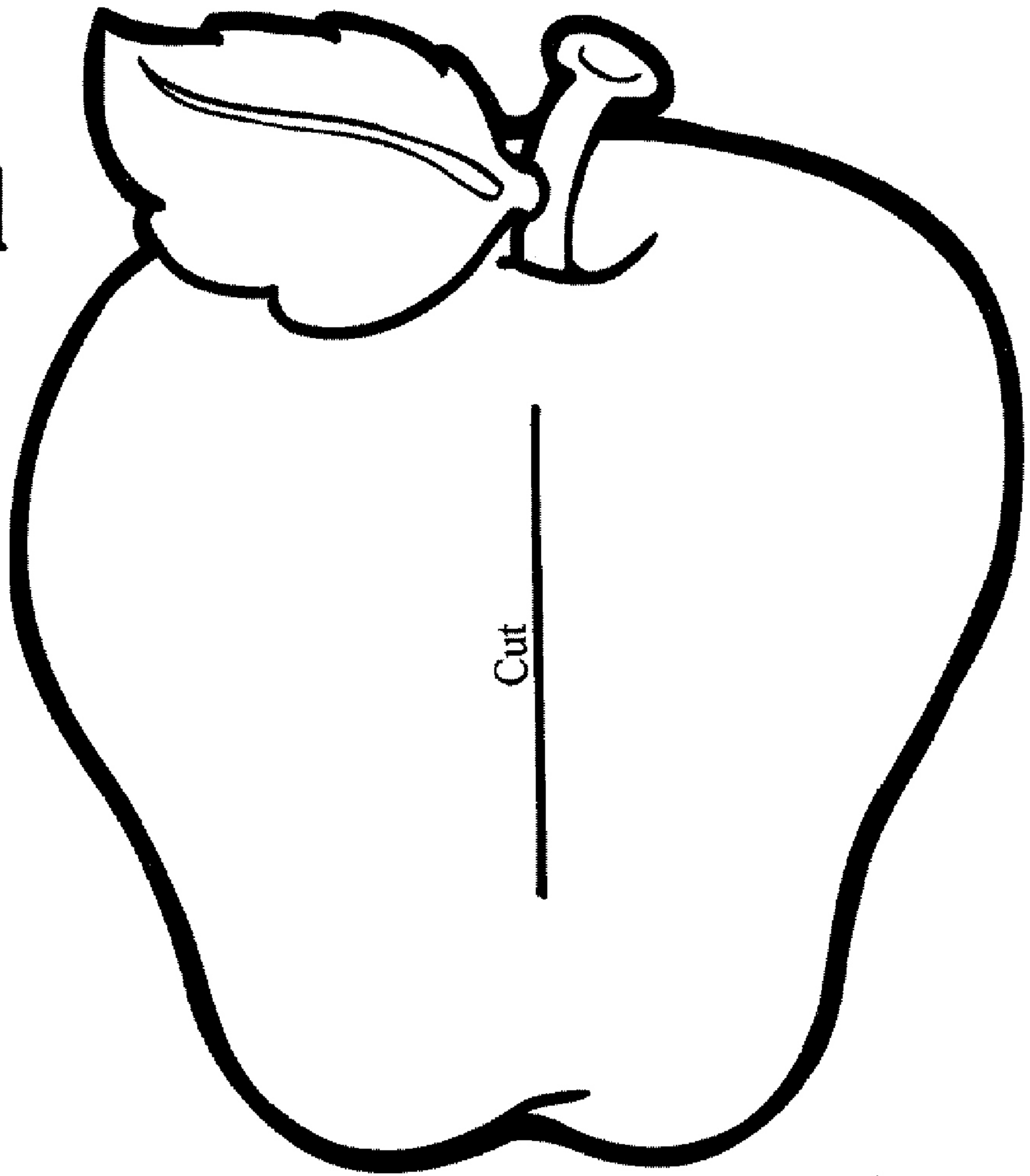
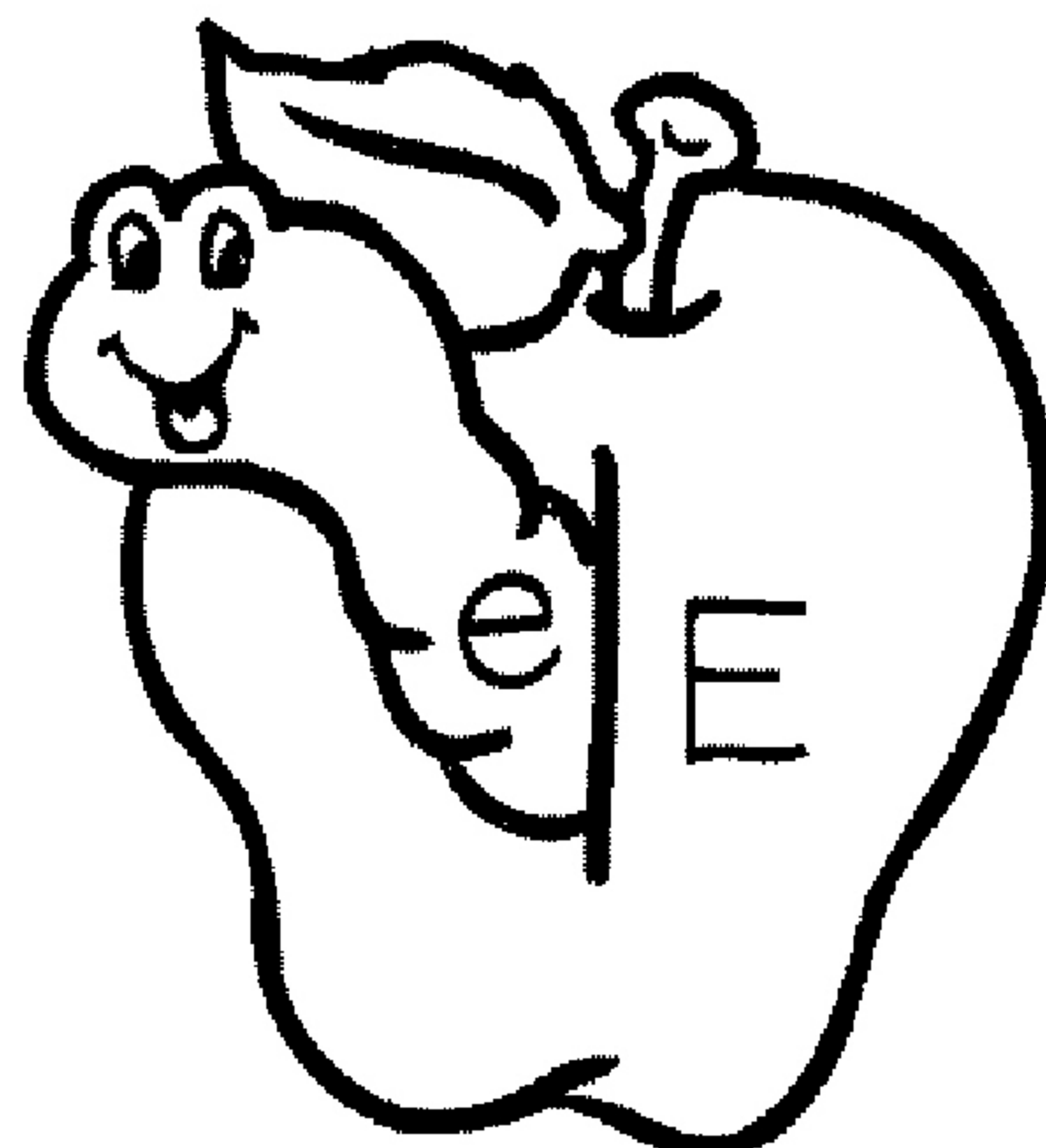
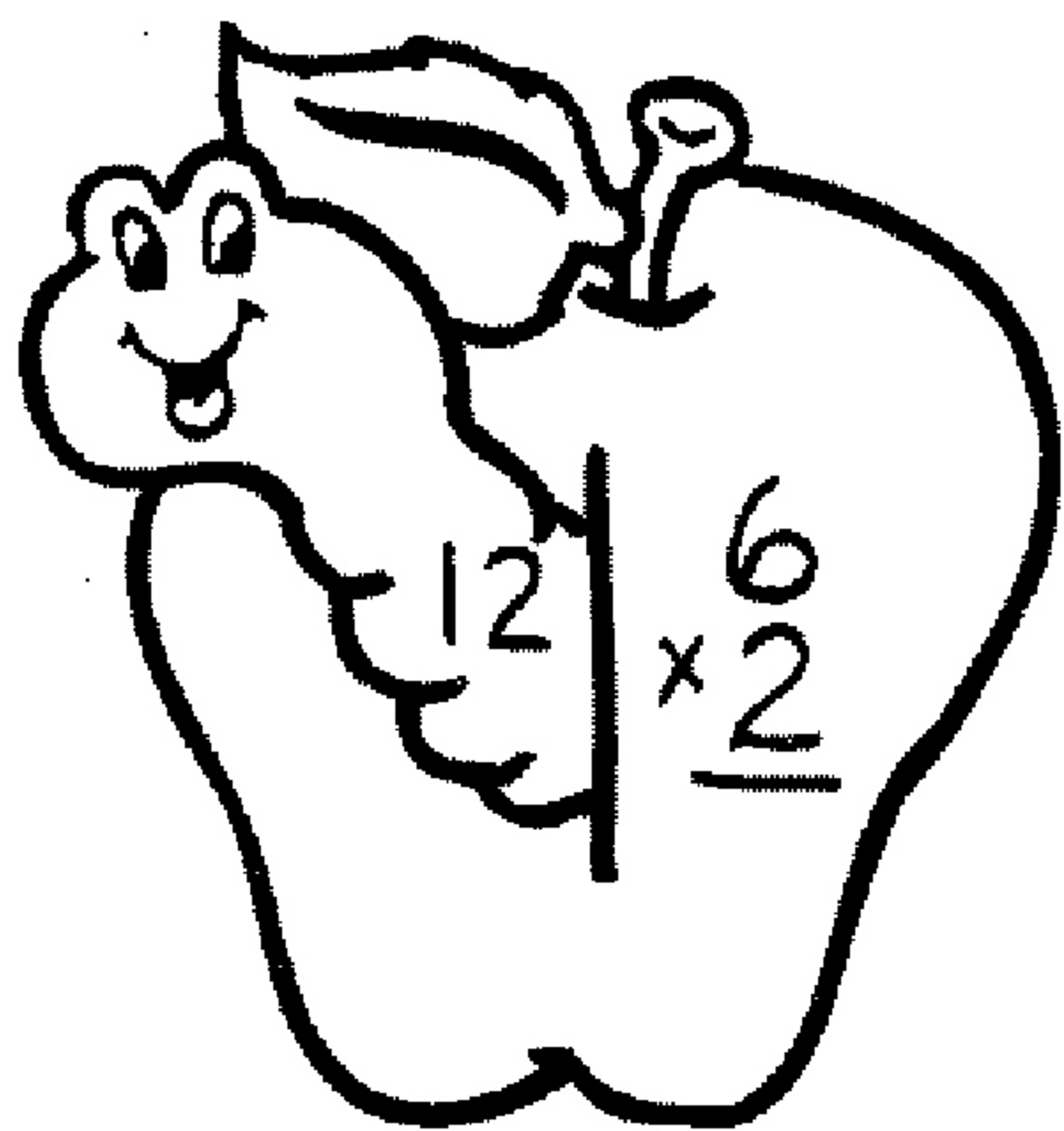


Matching Apples and Worms



Cutting several worms and apples from colored paper can make several matching activities. Math facts can be practiced by labeling each apple with a problem and a worm with the answer. Students match the two together, inserting the worm into the apple.
