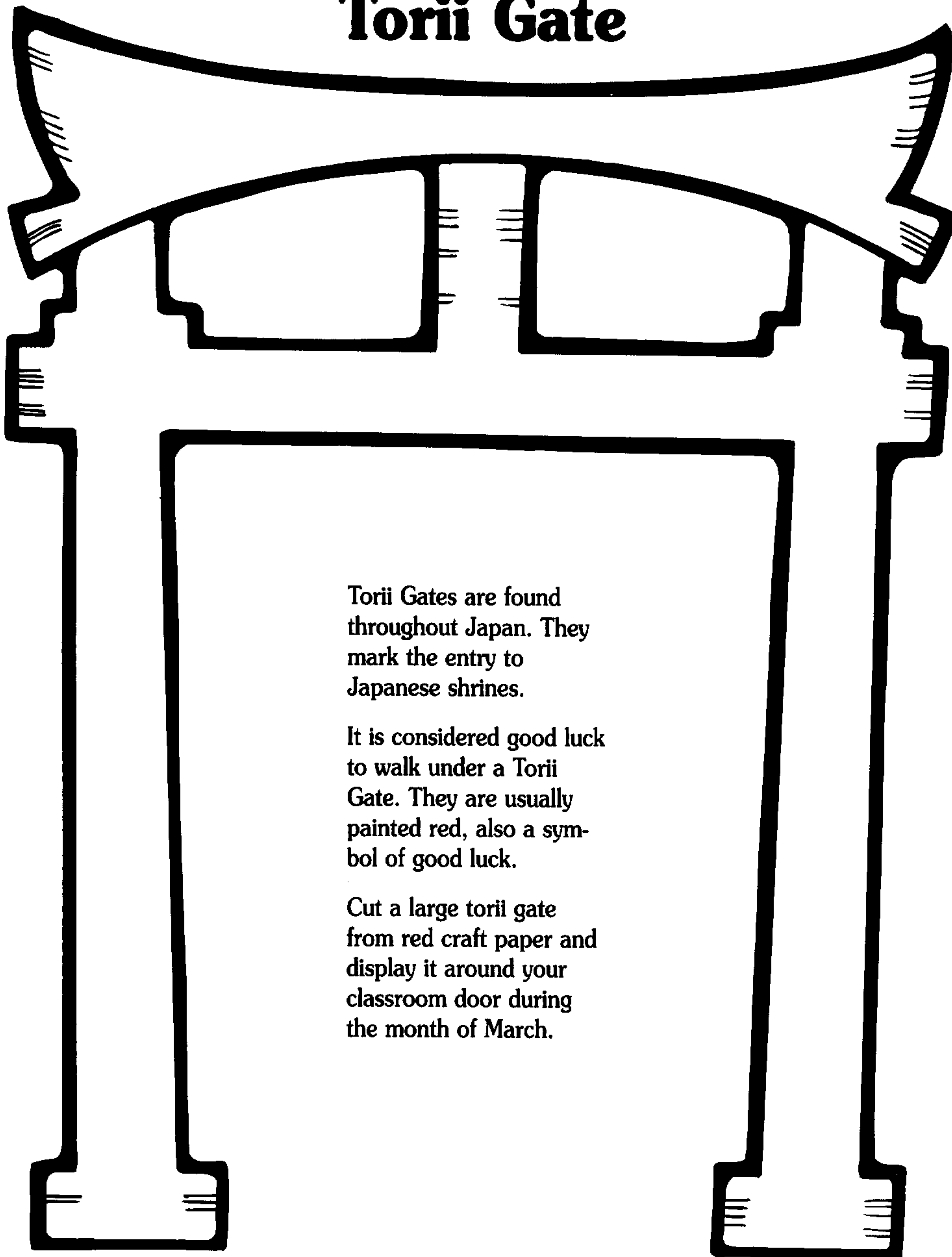


# Torii Gate



Torii Gates are found throughout Japan. They mark the entry to Japanese shrines.

It is considered good luck to walk under a Torii Gate. They are usually painted red, also a symbol of good luck.
