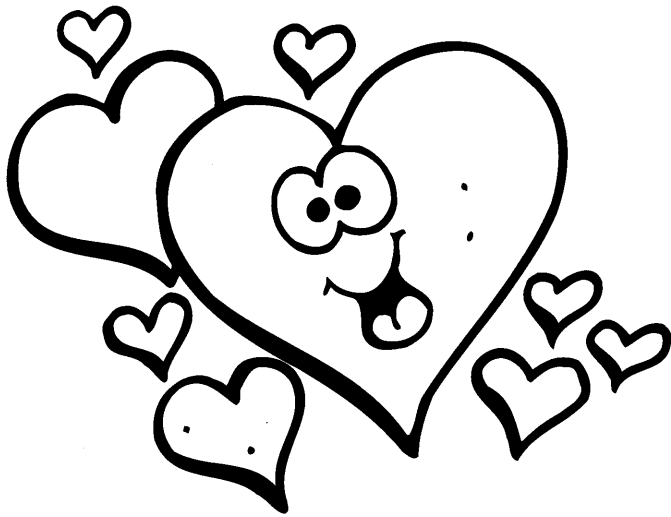


# FEBRUARY ACTIVITIES!
