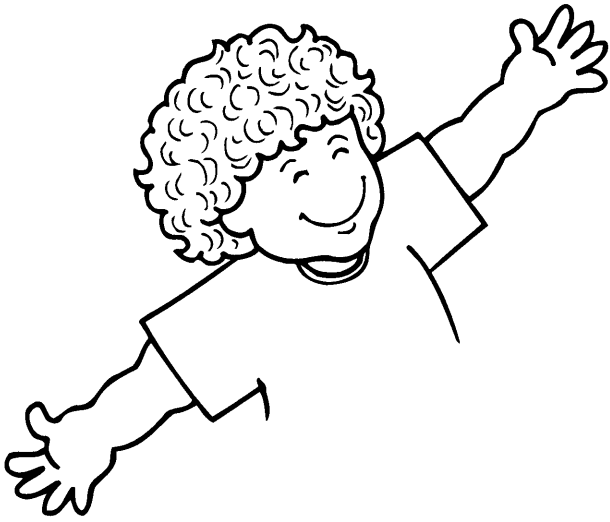


BLACK HISTORY ACTIVITIES!

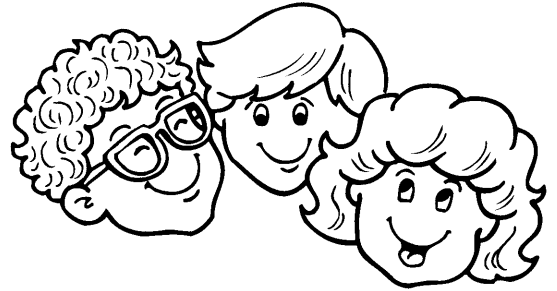


Ask each student to research and write about one Black American who has contributed greatly in one or more of the following areas:
