

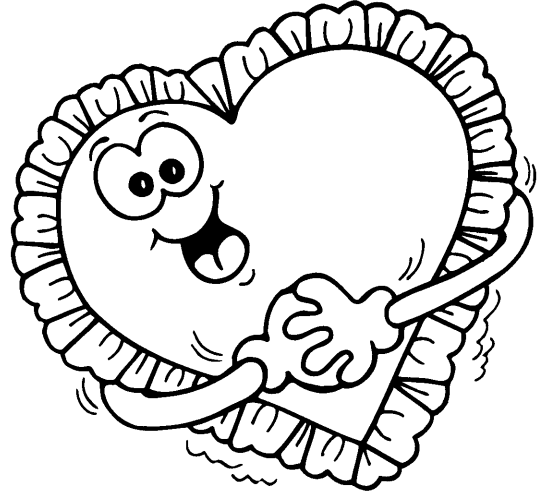

SUGGESTIONS FOR A FEBRUARY NEWSLETTER:

- List the name of each student that was selected student of the week for the month of January.
- Note the dates of Washington's and Lincoln's birthdays. Make sure that parents know which days children will not be in attendance.
- Announce special programs or parties being conducted by your school or in your classroom.
- Ask for parent volunteers or donations for the class Valentine's Day party.

- Ask one of your students to draw several small pictures about Valentine's Day or Presidents' Day.
- Ask your school principal to write a brief message that can be included with the February newsletter.
- Staple the February cafeteria menu to each newsletter.
- Send a welcome note to a new student or a get-well message to a student that has been out ill.

- This month starts a new semester in the school year. Include a list of your classroom goals for your students' parents. If your school schedules parent conferences during this month, remind them of the dates.
- Announce upcoming field trips, class plays, spelling bees or fund raisers.
