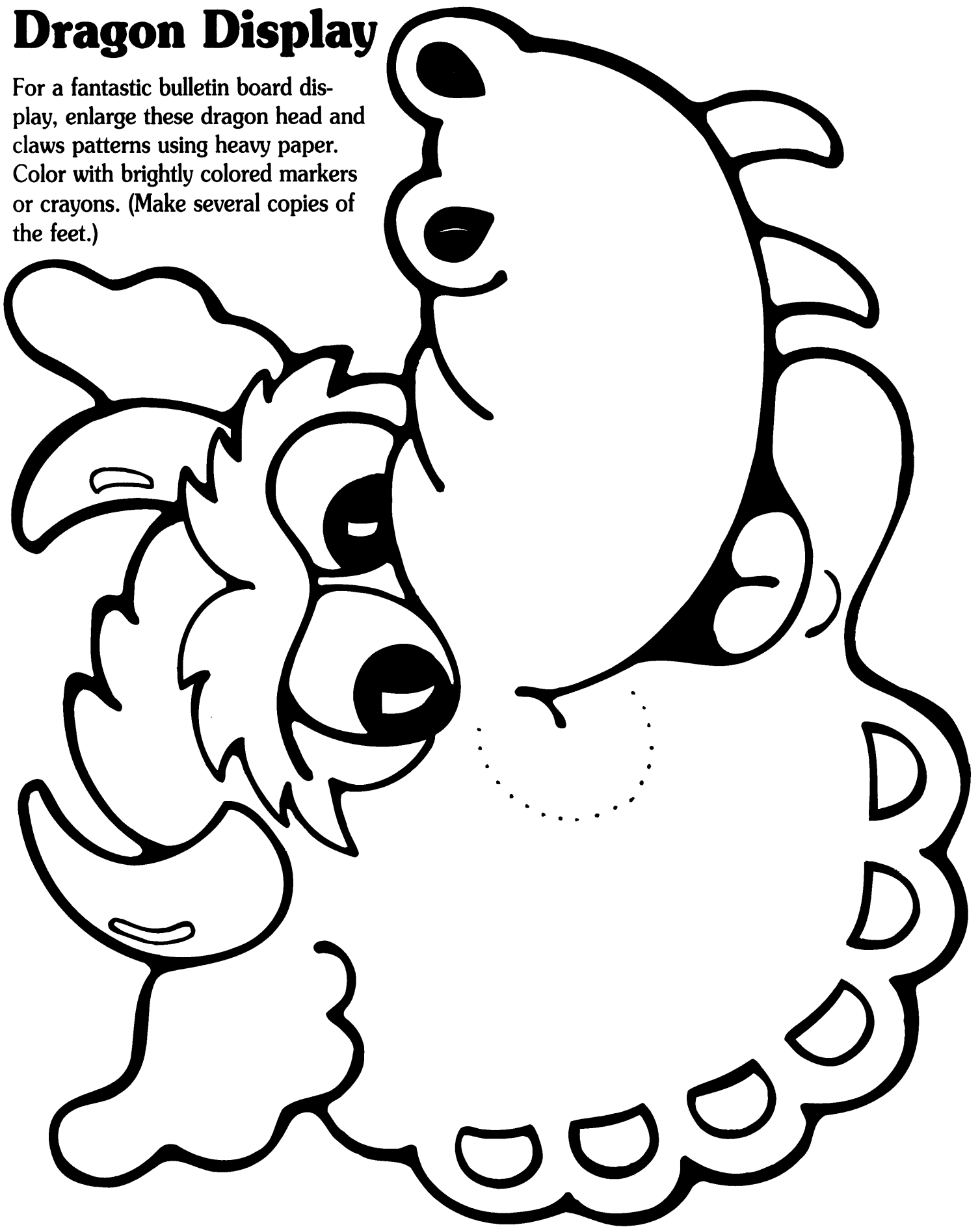
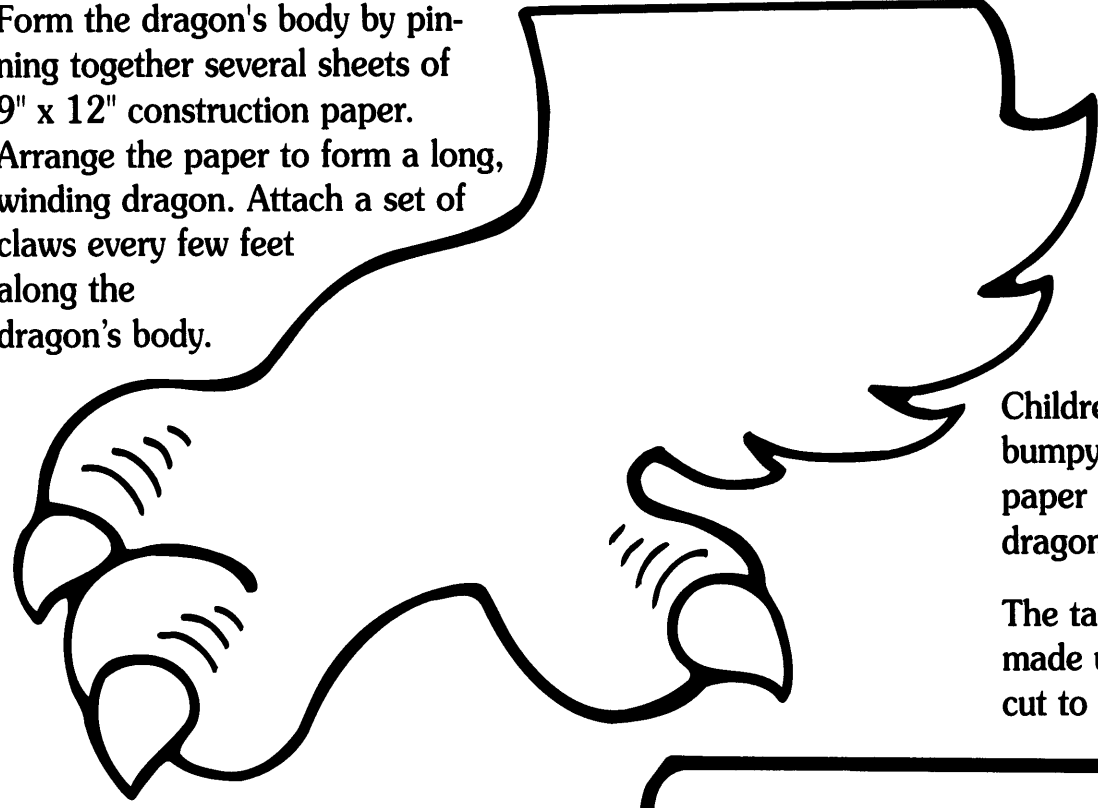


Dragon Display

For a fantastic bulletin board display, enlarge these dragon head and claws patterns using heavy paper. Color with brightly colored markers or crayons. (Make several copies of the feet.)

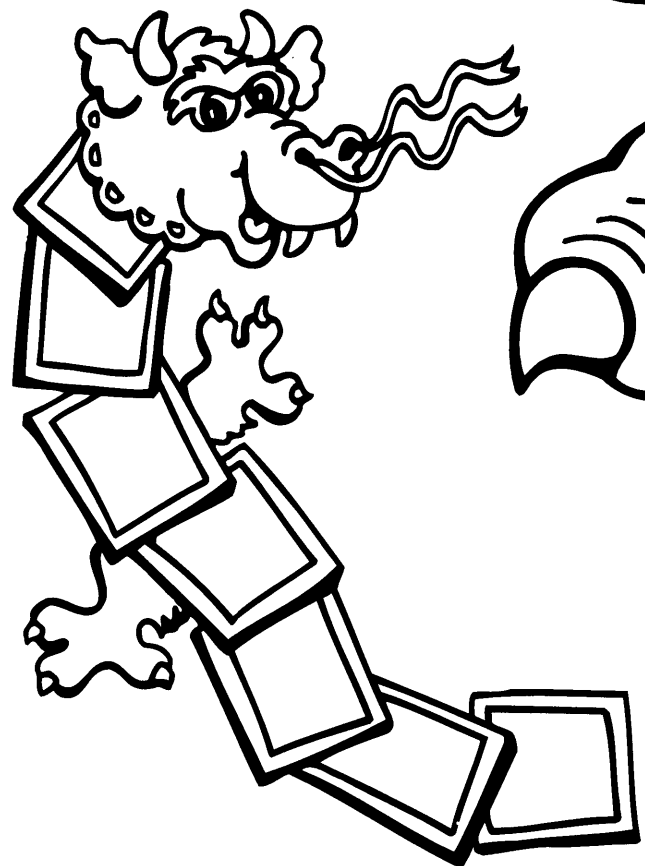
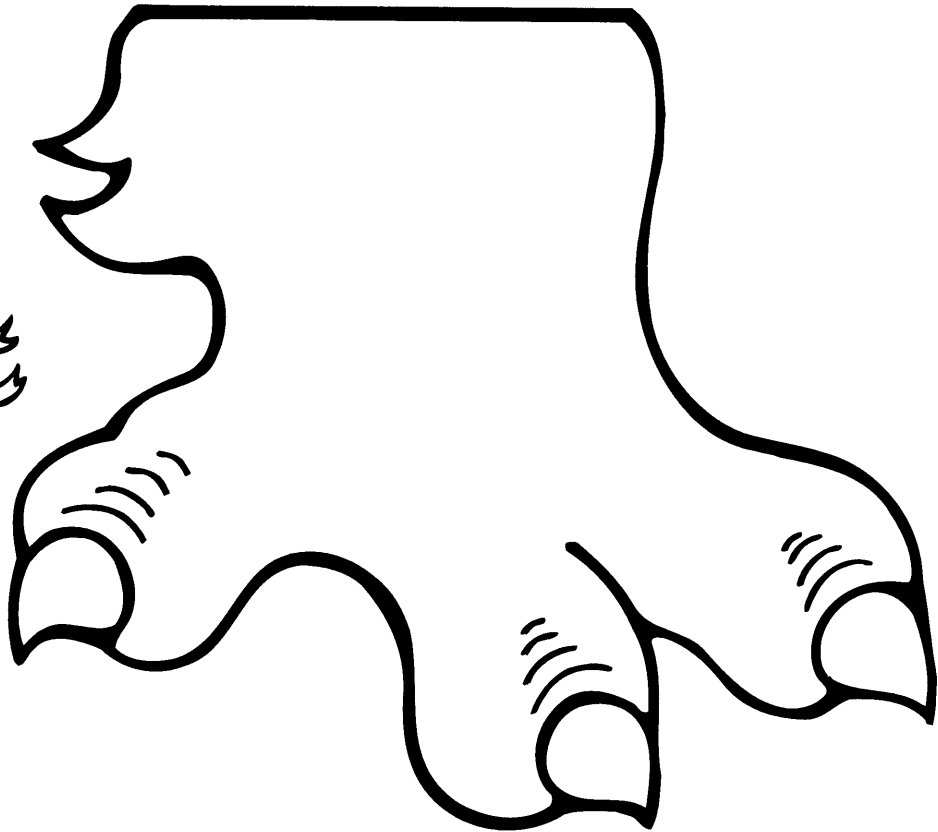


Form the dragon's body by pinning together several sheets of 9" x 12" construction paper. Arrange the paper to form a long, winding dragon. Attach a set of claws every few feet along the dragon's body.



Children may like to add bumpy paper scales and crepe paper streamers for the dragon's breath.

The tail of the dragon can be made using construction paper cut to form a tapered end.



On each sheet of construction paper, display a child's good work paper. This offers a wonderful display for writing assignments about dragons or research papers on the Chinese New Year!
