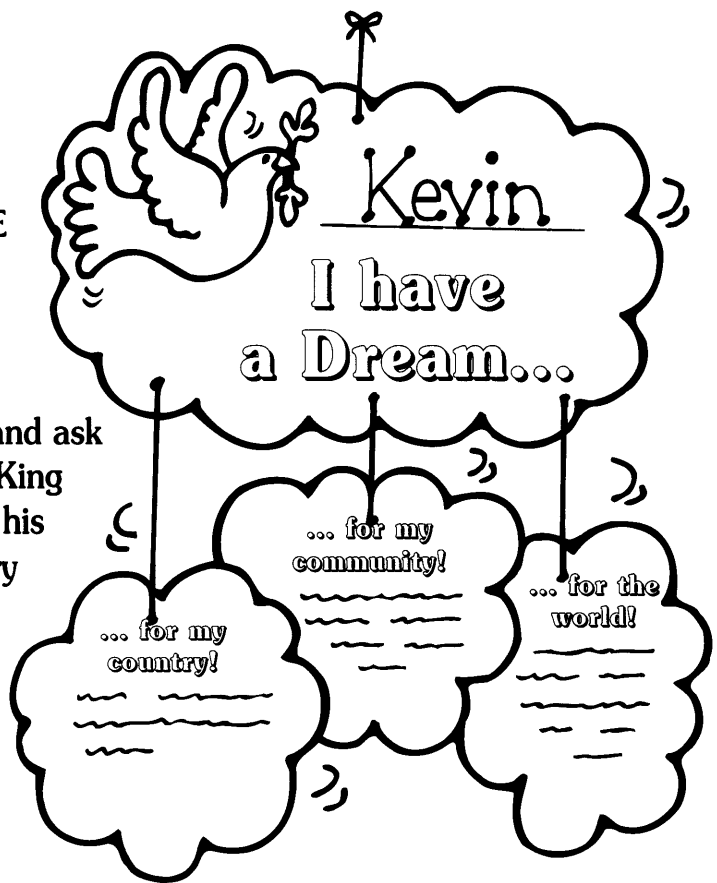


"Dream" Mobile

Each student can make his or her own "I HAVE A DREAM...MOBILE" using these simple patterns. Cut the mobile from white construction paper and assemble with yarn, as shown.

Read Martin Luther King's story to your class and ask the students to reflect on the "dream" that Dr. King had for our country. Ask each student to write his or her own "dream" for the community, country and world on the appropriate mobile pieces.

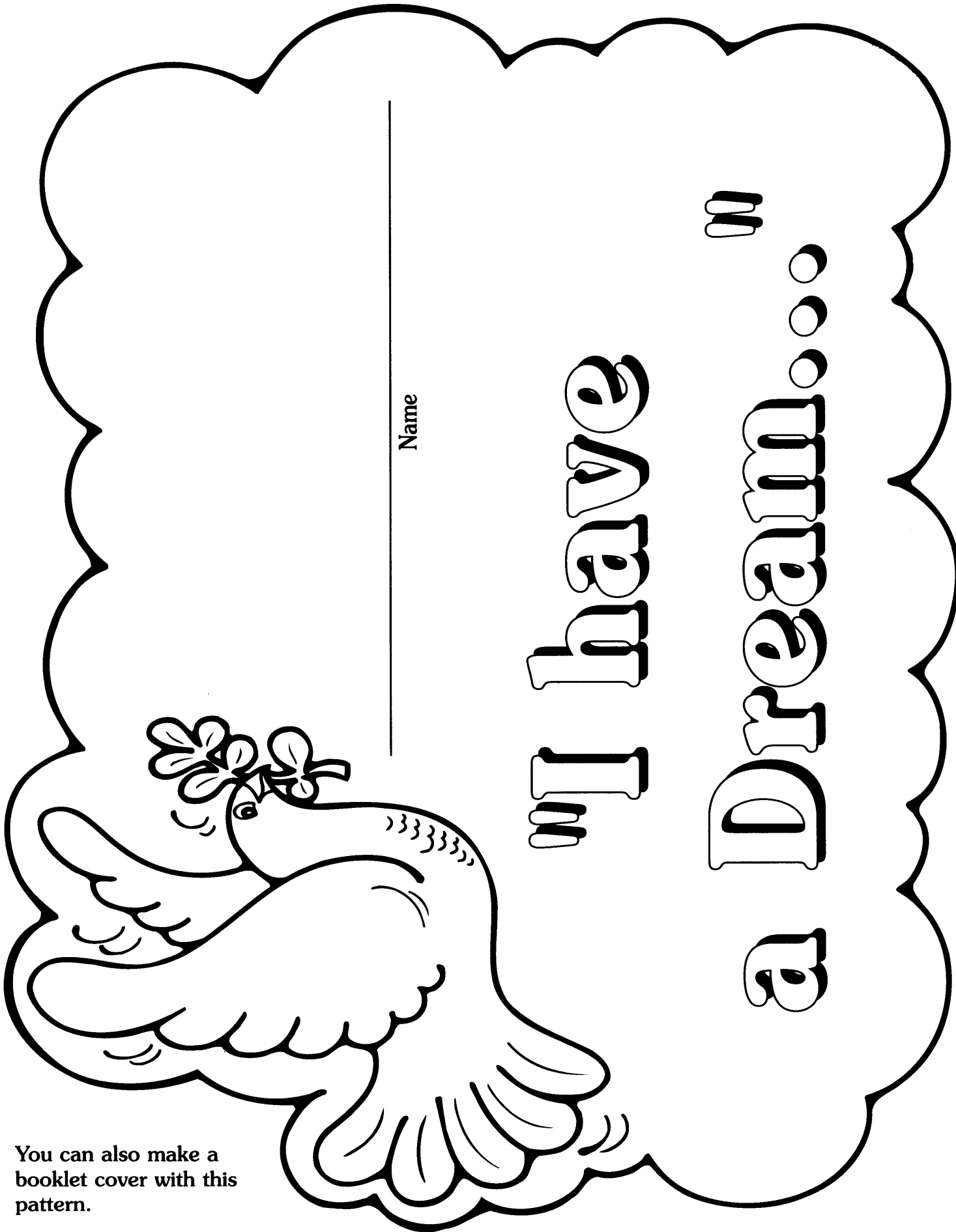
Tell them that their "dream" must be one that can succeed only if people care for one another and work together in harmony. Examples might include: world hunger, war, poverty, a clean environment, etc.
