Use this cute character to teach important street safety rules and vocabulary. A puppet can be made from the pattern. Make several copies of the helmet pattern on the next page. Write safety phrases or words on the helmet (one phrase or word per pattern). Each child can take a turn selecting a helmet. The teacher can then teach the meaning of the rule or word.



Rules and Vocabulary

When you ride your bike, wear a helmet.

Cross at the crosswalk.

Cross the street with a grown-up.

Wear safety gear when skating (helmet/knee pads).

Never play near the street at night.

Crossing guards help children cross the street safely.

Never run into the street after a ball.

Sit in the back and buckle up in the car.

Follow the traffic signs.
