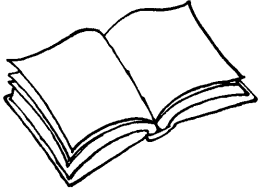


At Home With..... STREET SAFETY!!!!!!



Go to the library and read stories about bike and street safety.



We have been using a puppet called Claudia the Crossing Guard to help us learn about street safety rules. Ask your child what Claudia the Crossing Guard says about street safety. These are some of the rules:

When you ride your bike, wear a helmet.

Follow the traffic signs.

Cross at the crosswalk.

Stop at the corner.

Cross the street with a grown-up.

Wear safety gear when skating (helmet/knee pads).

Never play near the street at night.

Never run into the street after a ball.

Sit in the back and buckle up in the car.

Crossing guards help children cross the street safely.



When taking a walk around your neighborhood or when riding in your car, play a game to see how many "stop" signs you can find or how many "crosswalks" you can find or how many fire hydrants you pass by, etc. Point out any other traffic signs along the way. Practice following the street safety rules on your walk or ride.
