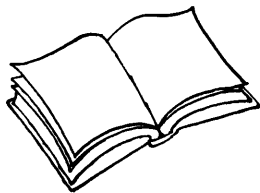


At Home With..... WATER SAFETY!!!!!!



Go to the library and read stories about water safety.



When you are near a pool (even a wading pool) or lake, ocean, etc., be certain that the children are well supervised by a competent adult.



We have been using a puppet called Leo the Life Guard to help us learn about water safety rules. Ask your child what Leo the Life Guard says about water safety. These are some of the rules:

Never swim alone.

Wear a life jacket in a boat.

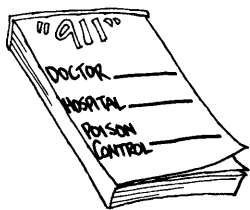
Life guards help to keep people safe in the water.

Never go into a pool or water without a grown-up.

If a toy falls into a pool, ask a grown-up for help.

Wear suntan lotion to protect your skin.

Wear protective clothing (i.e., sunglasses, hat, water shoes).



Keep a telephone, emergency telephone numbers, and emergency equipment with you when you are near the water.
